Overview

Salisbury Parks & Recreation, in conjunction with the Bradford Ski Area, is offering Ski & Snowboard Club. **No Transportation will be provided. Parents will be responsible for transporting students to and from the mountain.** There will be no monitors on the ski hills.

Season

Starts first week in January that Bradford is open and runs for 6 sessions.

*Does not meet February vacation week.

Registration:

October - November 9

Registration Form, Emergency Information Sheet, Liability Waiver, and Rental Form are available online and at the Salisbury Parks and Recreation office. Return all forms by mail, email, or in person to the Recreation office. Your registration is not complete until ALL forms and payment are received. Remember to sign the Liability Waiver Form.

Fees

Refunds

Refunds will be given between October 22- November 9. No refunds or credits will be issued after November 9. No refunds or credits will be issued if a child is absent from school or chooses not to attend.

Late Registration

Fee Registrations received after November 9 are subject to a \$40 late fee.

Late registrations will be accepted as long as there is space available. If all spaces fill, a waiting list will be taken.

Renting Equipment

Bradford Rental Forms are available online with the Registration Form, Emergency Information Sheet, and Liability Waiver. Be sure to include height, weight, and shoe size on the Rental Form. Form is two pages - please sign and initial where noted. Children renting helmets will keep the helmet for the season and return it on the last day. All other rental equipment is to be returned after each use.

Weather Cancellations

The Bradford Ski Area has the ability to make its own snow. Decisions regarding cancellation due to inclement weather or lack of snow will be made by Bradford Ski and Salisbury Recreation; sessions will be made up at the end. Schools will be notified when the program is canceled. Recreation will send emails home after 12:00 noon to notify parents. The Bradford Ski & Snowboard program is not held when schools are closed.

Lessons

All beginners are required to take lessons. If your child is a novice, intermediate, or advanced, you may choose not to enroll your child in lessons. To help prevent injury, please be aware of your child's skill level. If the ski instructor feels your child's ability is higher or lower than his/her class, the instructor will change your child's lesson accordingly. Once enrolled in a level, children will remain in it until the



instructor determines otherwise. * **Please note that Salisbury Recreation staff does not assist children in getting to their lessons and encourages children to always attend lessons if they have been registered in that package.** However, if a child chooses not to attend their lesson, or leaves a lesson early, Salisbury Recreation will not be able to issue refunds.

Description Ski/Snowboarding Level

Level 1 No experience

Level 2 The student can walk & climb in skis, get up from a fall, and glide in balance.

Level 3 The student can slow, stop, and turn in both directions.

Level 4 The student can link turns, ride lifts independently, and make large & small turns.

Mandatory Equipment

Ski helmets are mandatory for all participants. **You may not substitute with helmets from other sports.** Rental helmets are available from Bradford for a fee. Skiers will keep their rental helmets for the season and return it to Bradford at the end of the program.

Equipment

PLEASE LABEL ALL EQUIPMENT. Label skis or snowboard, poles, boots, bags, and helmets clearly using ELECTRICAL tape or DUCT tape with full name and town. Tie skis and poles together and put boots in a tote bag.

Salisbury Parks and Rec is not responsible for lost equipment or belongings.

Suggested Equipment/Packing

We suggest packing boots and all ski/snowboard gear in a backpack. Avoid, however, packing skis & poles or snowboards in bags, instead use a ski tote, ski grip, or ski-lash for easier mobility. Children must be able to carry all of their own equipment & bags - please pack accordingly.

Snack

The Slope Snack Bar at Bradford will be open before and after lessons for participants to purchase food & drinks. You may also bring a snack from home to be eaten at the lodge. NOTE: There is no scheduled snack break. Children are responsible for their own snack/break time and food purchases.

Dismissal

Child/ren must be signed out with a Salisbury Rec monitor at the ski area. Please note that Bradford Ski passes are only valid during the Salisbury Bradford Ski Program. For your child's safety, please adhere to these guidelines.

Children must be responsible for their own items. Salisbury Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen items
